2014 Fatalities Nationally

There were 91 firefighter deaths in 2014. 30 were career firefighters, 56 were volunteer and 5 were Wildland Agency deaths. Of the 91 firefighters who died while on duty in 2014, 89 were male and 2 were female. The break down is as follows;

**Career; 1 Industrial, 29 Urban/Suburban Fire Departments
Volunteer; 38 Rural, 18 Urban/Suburban Fire Departments
Wildland Agency; 2 Full time, 3 Part Time Seasonal**
